Free Crochet Pattern Part of a Nativity Set

Use a 'B' hook and sport weight cotton yarn to make a 1.5" figure. White and skin tone yarn required. Darning needle for sewing up. Small amount of toy stuffing.

Baby Jesus Body

Worked in Rows with a **TURN** at the end.

12 chain (ch)

Row 1

Beginning in third chain from the hook do 9 double crochet (dc) stitches along the row, then 1 half double crochet (hdc) stitch, then 2 chain. **TURN**

Row 2 (Shaping the body)

1 hdc, 6dc, 2 hdc, Don't turn yet but CARRY ON around the oval shape with 3 sc into the short side, 1 ch, 1 hdc, 1 ch, (7 dc and 2 hdc in between the stitches of the row below), 1 ch, (2 hdc into end of oval shape) 2 ch, 8 dc, 1 hdc, 6 sc, 1 hdc, 10 dc, (1 hdc into chain stitch from row below) 1 ch, 9 hdc, 2 chain **TURN**.

Row 3

3 hdc, 5 sc, 1 ss. Cast off leaving yarn for sewing up.

Baby Jesus Head

2 ch.

Round 1

Into second chain from the hook do 5 sc [5]

Round 2

2 sc into each stitch below [10]

Round 3

(1 sc, 2 sc into next stitch) x 5 [15]

Round 4

(1 sc, sc 2 together) x 5 [10] Stuff the head now.

Round 5

(1 sc, sc 2 together) x 3 then 1 sc, 1 slip stitch (ss) [7] Cast off leaving yarn to sew up.

Sewing up

The already stuffed head fits snugly into the open end of the body. Sew it firmly in place then stuff the body and sew it closed. Please supervise young children with this very small figure as it could be a choking hazard.



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
