

Crochet Snowman Motif Pattern USA terms

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Materials

White, black, orange and blue sport weight cotton yarn.

B hook & darning needle.

The three parts of the snowman's body (head, middle body & base body) are worked in a continuous round, with a stitch marker inserted into the work to mark each round. The hat and scarf (neck part and hanging-down part) are worked in rows, turning at the end of a row.

HEAD

2 chain.

Round 1.

Into the second chain from the hook, do 12 single crochet (sc) stitches. [12]

Insert a stitch marker.

Round 2.

2 sc into each stitch of round below [24] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 3.

24 sc [24] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 4.

24 sc. [24] Slip stitch (sl st) into next sc and fasten off leaving a tail for sewing up.

MIDDLE BODY

2 chain.

Round 1.

Into the second chain from the hook do 12 sc. [12] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 2.

2 sc into each stitch of round below. [24] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 3.

24 sc. [24] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 4.

24 sc. [24] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 5.

2 sc into each stitch of round below [48]

Slip stitch (sl st) into next sc and fasten off leaving a tail for sewing up.

BASE BODY

2 chain.

Round 1.

Into the second chain from the hook, do 12 single crochet (sc) stitches. [12]

Insert a stitch marker.

Round 2.

2 sc into each stitch of round below. [24] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 3.

24 sc [24] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 4.

24 sc [24] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 5.

2 sc into each stitch of round below [48] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 6.

48 sc [48] Insert a stitch marker.

Round 7.

48 sc [48] Slip stitch (sl st) into next sc and fasten off leaving a tail for sewing up.

HAT

11 chain.

Row 1.

Into second chain from hook do 1 sc, then 9sc more to end of row [10] TURN.

Row 2.

1 ch, 2 sl st, 2 ch, 1 sc into base of chain, 6 sc, TURN.

Row 3.

1 ch, 1 sc into base of chain, 7 sc, TURN.

Row 4.

1 ch, 1 sc into base of chain, 7 sc. Fasten off.

SCARF - neck part

7 chain.

Row 1.

Into second chain from hook do 1 sc, then 5sc more to end of row [6] TURN.

Row 2.

1 ch, 6 sc. Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing up.

SCARF - hanging down part

9 chain.

Row 1.

Into second chain from hook do 1 sc, then 7sc more to end of row [8] TURN.

Row 2.

1 ch, 8 sc. Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing up.

NOSE

5 chain.

Row 1.

1 double crochet (dc) into third chain from hook, 1 half double crochet (hdc), 1 sl st. Cut the yarn about 5" in length, then pull BOTH cut ends of yarn through the loop on the hook to fasten off.

Below you can see the crochet pieces ready to be sewn up to make the snowman motif...



SEWING UP THE SNOWMAN MOTIF

- 1) Sew in both loose ends on the hat.
- 2) Use white yarn from the head to sew the hat to the head, and then sew in the other loose end on the head.
- 3) Use yarn from the nose to sew it onto the head.
- 4) Use yarn from middle body to sew head to middle body (slightly overlap the head onto the body).
- 5) Use yarn from neck part of the scarf to sew onto neck area of the snowman.
- 6) Use yarn from the hanging-down part of the scarf to sew it to the snowman on his middle body.
- 7) Use white yarn from base body to sew to middle body (slightly overlap the middle body onto the base body).
- 8) Use black yarn to sew the snowman's eyes and mouth.

The snowman motif is now complete and ready to be sewn onto a project of your choice. Below you can see the snowman motif has been sewn onto a felt Christmas stocking.
