Stand up Figure or finger puppet

Use a 2mm hook and 4 ply cotton yarn to make a 2.5" figure or finger puppet. Blue and skin tone yarn required. Darning needle for sewing up. Small amount of toy stuffing.

Mary's Body

Worked in Rounds with a stitch marker.

2 chain (ch)

Round 1

Into second chain from the hook do 6 double crochet (dc) stitches.
[6]

Round 2

2 dc into the first stitch, (1 dc, 1 htr) into next stitch, 2 htr in next stitch, (1 htr, 1 dc) in next stitch, (2 dc into next stitch) x2 [12]

Round 3

12 dc [12]

Round 4

12 dc [12]

Round 5

(2 dc, then 2 dc into next stitch) x3 then do 3 dc. [15]

Round 6

15 dc [15]

Round 7

15 dc [15]

Round 8

1 chain, 15 trebles (tr) [15]

Round 9

Dc into chain stitch from row below then 15 more dc. [16]

Rounds 10 to 13

16 dc [16] 1 ss. Cast off and weave in end.

Mary's Head

Worked in Rounds with a stitch marker.

2 ch.

Round 1

Into second chain from the hook do 5 dc [5]

Round 2

2 dc into each stitch below [10]

Round 3

(1 dc, 2 dc into next stitch) x 5 [15]

Round 4

(1 dc, dc 2 together) x 5 [10]

Round 5

10 dc [10] Stuff the head now.

Round 6

(1 dc, dc 2 together) x 3 then 1 dc, 1 slip stitch (ss) [7] Cast off leaving yarn to sew up.

Mary's Headress.

Worked in Rows with a **TURN** at the end of a row.

11 chain

Row 1

Begin in second chain from the hook, do 10 dc, 2 chain. **TURN**

Row 2

10 tr, 2ch. **TURN**

Row 3

10 tr, 1ch. **TURN**

Row 4 (shaping begins)

9 dc. Continue crocheting around corner with 2dc stitches together into the corner stitch and then 3 dc along short side of the rectangle. **TURN**

Row 5

14 dc 1 chain **TURN**

Row 6

Do double crochet stitches **all the way around** the outside edge of the headdress with (1dc, 1 htr, 1 dc) into the first corner and (1 dc, 1htr) at the end of the row. Cast off leaving yarn to sew up.

NOTE: the wrong side of the crochet is the right side of the headdress.

Mary's Arms (make one because her arms are joined at the hands).

11 chain

Row 1

Begin in third chain from hook, do 9 htr. Cast off leaving yarn to sew up.

Base of Mary figure (NOT needed for finger puppet)

Worked in Rounds with a stitch marker used.

2 chain (ch)

Round 1

Into second chain from the hook do 6 dc. [6]

Round 2

2 htr into each stitch below [12] 1 ss cast off leaving a yarn to sew up.

Sewing up

The top of the body is shaped to slightly tilt so that Mary's head is sewn onto the body with a downward tilting angle. Sew the arms across the body and stitch 'hands' in skin tone over the middle of the arm length. The headdress is shaped and is sewn to the head and back. The finger puppet is complete now or stuff and sew on base if a stand up figure is being made.



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
