A Free Crochet Pattern By A.B.McKenna 2012 USA terms

Use a B1 hook and Sports weight yarn

Begin with 8 chain and join with a ss.

Round 1: 1 chain then into the base ring do 1 sc, [do 3 ch, then into base ring do 1 tr, 3 ch, 1sc into base ring] Pull stitches close to form a neat petal. Repeat 6x more to make 7 petals. Ss into first sc.

Round 2: Ss into each of next three chain and the triple crochet stitch below. [12 ch, 1dc into 9th chain from hook, 3 ch, ss to top of next tr below which is the top of the next petal.] Repeat 6x more and there will be 7 petals. The final ss goes into the 1st chain stitch not the tr stitch below.

Round 3: Work 3 ss. * Do 3ch, [then into 8 chain space below do 1 dc, 3 ch] x4 Then ss into double crochet stitch below. Work 3 ss down the chain towards the tip of the inner petal, then 3 ss back up the chain away from the inner petal. *

Repeat from * to * 6x more. After seven petals do just 3 ss and stop where the round began.

Round 4: [Do 3 sc into each of the next three chain spaces.

Into next chain space do 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1tr, 1 hdc, 1 sc.

Do 3 sc into each of the next three chain spaces] Repeat 6x more so all 7 petals are done. Ss and cast off.
